

## New tenant checklist

1	Update your property photographs and description
2	Advertise on your chosen platform
3	Book add-on & compliance services
4	Screen your enquiries
5	Review screening responses
6	Arrange viewings
7	Select a tenant, take holding deposit & send 'how to rent' guide
8	Pause your advert
9	Reference your chosen applicant
10	Share necessary documents  It should contain your  - Energy Performance Certificate (EPC),  - Electrical Installation Condition Report (EICR),  - Gas safety certificate (CP12),  - Inventory (if you already have one),
11	Tenant signs tenancy agreement

13	Sign the tenancy agreement
14	Protect deposit & update your insurance
15	Provide essential documents  It is mandatory at this stage to have provided the following:  - Energy Performance Certificate (EPC),  - Electrical Installation Condition Report (EICR),  - Gas safety certificate (CP12),  - Inventory (if you are not performing a walk through on move in day),  - Tenancy agreement (AST) for the property,  - Deposit protection certificate and prescribed information  - How to rent checklist (England only)
16	Spruce up the property
17	Perform check-in walk through/inventory
18	Sign acknowledgement receipt
19	Handover keys
20	Set up direct debit
21	Cancel property advert
